Youngsville Recreational Sports Programs Q&A

Q- Why Youngsville Recreational Sports Programs?

A- Our goal is to provide quality recreational programs for the growth and development of our city's youth. We want to develop parks and recreation for the city of Youngsville, into a great organization, that meets and exceeds the citizens' expectations.

Q- Where do I register?

A- You can register online at www.YoungsvilleSportsComplex.com

Q- When do I register?

A- Registration will begin February 1st with Youngsville residents, registering the first week. Registration will open to the surrounding communities by February 8th and will continue until March 4th.

Q- What sports will be available in the Spring?

A- Tee ball, Baseball and Softball will be available in the Spring.

Q- Are there any sports in the Spring that are co-ed?

A- The only sport that is co-ed is 4-year-old Tee ball.

Q- What sports will be available in the Fall?

A- Youth Basketball and Volleyball will be available in the fall. Adult sports that will be available in the fall include Softball and Pickle-ball. More sports will eventually be added.

Q- What are the age groups?

A- Our youth sports will be available for children 4 through 14. The adult sports will be available for ages 18 and older.

Q- Do I have to live in Youngsville in order to join any Spring leagues?

A- No. Anyone can play for league play. For All-Star play, see next question.

Q- If I do not live in Youngsville, will I be eligible for PONY Baseball/Softball All-stars?

A- Boys- Any residence that falls in the Youngsville and Broussard zones would be eligible for All-Star play. Any residence that falls outside of the Youngsville and Broussard zones, would be eligible to play in the league but NOT eligible for All-Star play.

Girls- The residence does not matter. Girls are eligible for league play and All-star play no matter where their residence is located.

Q- What is the cost per child?

A- Youngsville residents will be charged \$70.00 per child. Non-residents will be charged \$80.00 per child.

Q- Is there a family discount?

A- Yes. There is a sibling discount of \$15.00 per child after the first child. Residents will be charged \$55.00 per child, after the first child. Non-residents will be charged \$65.00 per child, after the first child.

Q- Is there a late registration fee?

A- Yes. There will be a \$20.00 late fee after March 4th.

Q- When does practice start?

A- March 28th

Q- What days are practice?

A- Monday through Friday

Q- When will games start?

A- Baseball/Softball day will be April 23rd. Games will begin on April 25th.

Q- When will the games be played?

A- The games will be played Monday through Friday.

Q- What affiliation will your Baseball/Softball league be?

A- We will be affiliated with PONY Baseball/Softball rules and regulations.
